A Resolution Adopting a Road Policy for Wells Township

Whereas, Minn. Statute #164.02 establishes the Town Board as the authority for establishing, locating, relocating, constructing, reconstructing, improving and maintaining township roads.

Whereas, the Township is authorized to appropriate and expend such sums of money from their town road and bridge funds as they deem necessary for the establishment, location, relocation, construction, improvement and maintenance of such roads.

Whereas, the town board determined, after balancing various policy considerations, that designating a road policy serves the public interest by providing guidelines for establishing, locating, relocating, constructing, reconstructing, improving and maintaining township roads.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the town board of Wells Township, Rice County, Minnesota does hereby designate the attached policy as the formal Wells Township road policy and supersedes any prior road policy and subordinate service district resolutions.
